The Points towards a Championship shall be awarded to the Winners Dog and Bitch of each breed or variety based on the actual number of dogs or bitches competing in that breed or variety.

If the dog designated Winners Dog or Winners Bitch is also awarded Best of Breed or Variety, the dogs of both sexes that have been entered for Best of Breed or Variety competition and that have been defeated in such competition, shall be counted in addition to the dogs that competed in the regular classes for its sex in calculating championship points.

If the dog designated Winners Dog or Winners Bitch is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed or Variety, the dogs of its own sex that have been entered for Best of Breed or Variety competition that have been defeated in competition for Best of Opposite Sex, shall be counted in addition to the dogs that competed in the regular classes for its sex in calculating championship points.

After points have been computed for Winners Dog and Winners Bitch subject to the above two stipulations, the dog awarded the Best of Winners shall be credited with the number of points calculated for Winners Dog or Winners Bitch, whichever is greater.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, or from which all awards are withheld, shall not be included. Any dog which shall have won fifteen points shall become a Champion of Record, if six or more of said points shall have been won at two shows with a rating of three or more championship points each and under two different judges, and some one or more of the balance of said points shall have been won under some other judge or judges than the two judges referred to above.

After 30% deduction for expenses, the remaining Sweepstakes entry fees shall be awarded to the class winners on a proportional basis as follows:

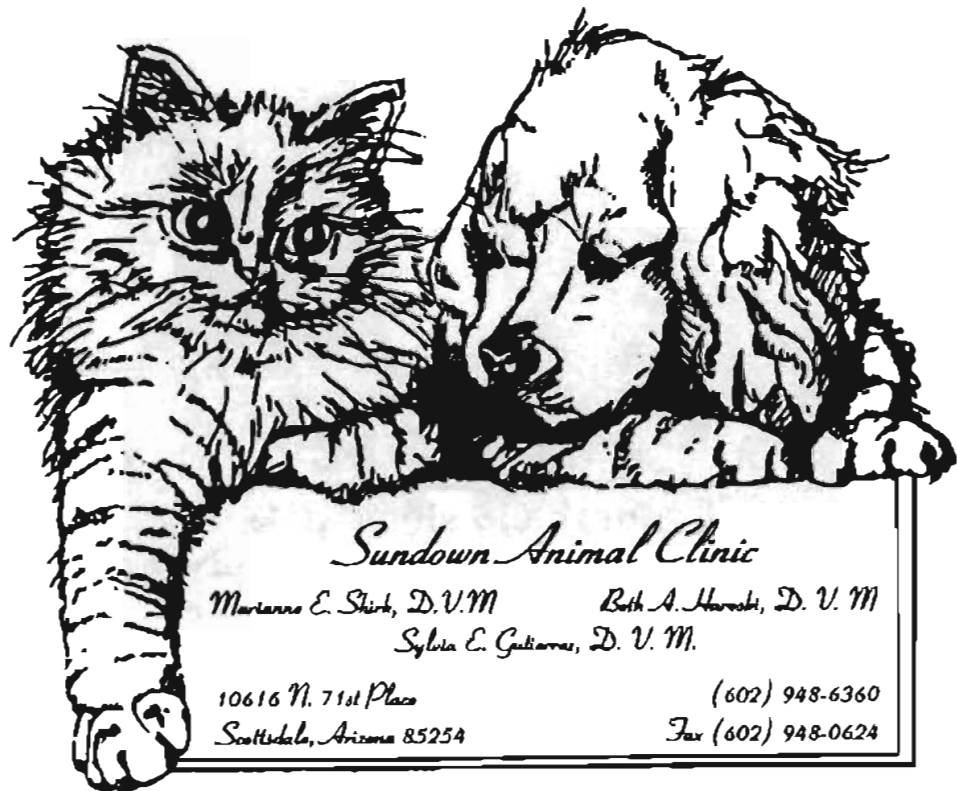

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Conditional, unsigned, incomplete, telegraphed or telephoned entries cannot be accepted. Entries must be on official AKC forms with the AKC agreement on reverse side.

Owners are responsible for errors on entry blanks.

Entry fees will not be refunded in event of error or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to an incorrect entry.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Treasurer will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

Refund for cancellations prior to closing will be made after the show.

A recording fee of \$.50 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show, obedience trial or tracking test. This recording fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (Chapter 11, Section 2 of the AKC Dog Show Rules)

There is no provision offered for unentered dogs at this show.

Dogs must be ready for judging. No provisions are available for notifying exhibitors or their agents of class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

Dogs need to be at the show only at scheduled judging time and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging.

Dogs must be held on leash or kept in pens/crates except when being judged.

Grooming, exercising and crating must be done in designated areas only.

All prizes must be claimed the day of the show. Trophies not claimed the day become the property of Irish Setter Club of Arizona.

The IRISH SETTER CLUB of ARIZONA, INC will not be liable for any loss, theft, injury and/or death of dogs entered in the show, whether said loss, theft, injury and/or death is caused by carelessness or negligence of any other person or by any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care, custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

Code of Ethics

I will endeavor to maintain the following practices to the best of my ability.

- 1) To maintain high standards of health and care for my dogs.
- 2) To comply with all AKC and Irish Setter Club of America Rules and Regulations.
- 3) To promote knowledge of the breed to the general public.
- 4) To make every effort to learn about the structure, anatomy, inherited traits and behavior of the dog, especially as such learning applies to the sporting breeds; specifically as it applies to the Irish Setter. To study the standard and visualization of same (as printed by the Irish setter Club of America) in an effort to breed a true, sound type setter.
- 5) To demonstrate sportsmanship at all AKC and Irish Setter Club of Arizona functions.
- 6) To contribute to and support AKC and Irish Setter Club of Arizona functions.
- 7) To subscribe fully to the Code of Conduct.

Code of Conduct

As a member of the Irish Setter Club of Arizona, Inc., I agree to adhere to the following code of conduct. I understand that willful violation of any section of this code can result in my censure, suspension or expulsion from the Irish Setter Club of Arizona, Inc. per article 6, section 1 through 4 of the constitution and by-laws.

- 1) To use or give service only to registered stock that is:
 - A. Physically and temperamentally sound.
 - B. Free from abnormalities considered to be genetic and certified free of hip dysplasia by orthopedic foundation for animals (OFA) or a qualified veterinarian using OFA methods.
- 2) To maintain accurate health, breeding, registration and pedigree records, and to pass on the record to buyers of puppies and/or adults dogs within a reasonable period of time.
- 3) To withhold registration papers on any dog that has readily detectable defects or a nature that will make it detrimental to the breed, and in such cases, obtain written agreements from the buyer as required by the AKC, or obtain written agreement from the buyer that this animal will not be used for breeding.
- 4) Not to sell stock without true representation to the purchaser or to use misleading or untruthful statements in selling or advertising.
- 5) No sale of animal to any commercial enterprise, the purpose of which is resale.
- 6) To use a sale contract or written agreement to cover any sale, purchase or service involving an Irish Setter.
- 7) As a breeder agree to:
 - A) Ascertain the ability and willingness of prospective buyers to maintain and care for the dogs properly.
 - B) Replace or refund for any stock that is sold upon receipt of acceptable evidence from a qualified veterinarian that it is not genetically sound and in good health in accordance with terms and conditions of contract.

IRISH SETTER CLUB OF AMERICA Revised Standard for Irish Setters

General Appearance

The Irish Setter is an active, aristocratic bird dog, rich red in color, substantial yet elegant in build. Standing over two feet tall at the shoulder, the dog has a straight, fine glossy coat, longer on ears, chest, tail and back of legs. Afield, the Irish Setter is a swift-moving hunter, at home, a sweet natured, trainable companion.

At their best, the lines of the Irish Setter so satisfy in overall balance that artists have termed it the most beautiful of all dogs. The correct specimen always exhibits balance, whether standing or in motion. Each part of the dog flows and fits smoothly into its neighboring parts without calling attention to itself.

Size, Proportion, Substance

There is no disqualification as to size. The make and fit of all parts and their overall balance in the animal are rated more important. Twenty seven inches at the withers and a show weight of about 70 pounds is considered ideal for the dog; the bitch 25 inches, 60 pounds. Variance beyond an inch up or down is to be discouraged.

Proportion: Measuring from the breastbone to rear of thigh and from the top of the withers to the ground the Irish Setter is slightly longer than it is tall.

Substance: All legs sturdy with plenty of bone. Substance in the male reflects masculinity without coarseness. Bitches appear feminine without being slight of bone.

Head

Long and lean, its length at least double between the ears. Beauty of head is emphasized by delicate chiseling along the muzzle, around and below the eyes, and along the cheeks.

Expression soft and alert. Eyes somewhat almond shaped, of medium size, placed rather well apart, neither deep set nor bulging. Color, dark to medium brown. Eye set well back and low, not above level of eye. Leather thin, hanging in a neat fold close to the head, and nearly long enough to reach the nose.

The skull is oval when viewed from above or front; very slightly domed when viewed in profile. The brow is raised, showing a distinct stop midway between the tip of the nose and the well-defined occiput (rear point of skull). Thus the nearly level line from occiput to brow is set a little above, and parallel to, the straight and equal line from eye to nose. Muzzle moderately deep, jaws of nearly equal length, the underline of the jaws being almost parallel with the top of the muzzle. Nose black or chocolate; nostrils wide. Upper lips fairly square but not pendulous. The teeth meet in a scissors bite in which the upper incisors fit closely over the lower, or they may meet evenly.

Neck, Top line and Body

Neck moderately long, strong but not thick, and slightly arched; free from throatiness and fitting smoothly into the shoulders. Top line of body from withers to tail should be firm and incline slightly downward without sharp drop at the

croup. The tail is set on nearly level with the croup as a natural extension of the top line, strong at root tapering to a finepoint, nearly long enough to reach the hock. Carriage straight or curving slightly upward, level with the back sufficiently long to permit a straight and free stride.

Chest deep, reaching approximately to the elbows with moderate forechest, extending beyond the point where the shoulder joins the upper arm. Chest is of moderate width so that it does not interfere with forward motion and extends rearwards to well sprung ribs. Loins firm, muscular and of moderate length.

Forequarters. Shoulder blades long, wide, sloping well back, fairly close together at the withers. Upper arm and shoulder blades are approximately the same length, and are joined at sufficient angle to bring the elbows rearward along the brisket in line with the top of the withers. The elbows moving freely incline neither in nor out. Forelegs straight and sinewy. Strong, nearly straight pastern. Feet rather small, very firm, toes arched and close.

Hindquarters: Hindquarters should be wide and powerful with broad, well developed thighs. Hind legs long and muscular from hip to hock; short and perpendicular from hock to ground; well angulated at stifle and hock joints, which, like the elbows, incline neither in nor out. Feet as in front. Angulation of the forequarters and hindquarters should be balanced.

Coat

Short and fine on head and forelegs. On all other parts of moderate length and flat. Feathering long and silky on ears; on back of forelegs and thighs long and fine, with a pleasing fringe of hair on belly and brisket extending onto chest. Fringe on tail moderately long and tapering. All coat and feathering as straight and free as possible from curl or wave. The Irish Setter is trimmed for the show ring to emphasize the lean head and dean neck. The top third of the ears and the throat nearly to the breastbone are trimmed. Excess feathering is removed to show the outline of the foot. All trimming is done to preserve the natural appearance of the dog.

Color: Mahogany or rich chestnut red with no black. A small amount of white on chest, throat or toes, or a narrow centered streak on skull is not to be penalized.

Gait

At the trot the gait is big, very lively, graceful and efficient. At an extended trot the head reaches slightly forward, keeping the dog in balance. The forelegs reach well ahead as if to pull in the ground without giving the appearance of a hackney gait. The hindquarters drive smoothly and with great power. Seen from the front or rear, the forelegs, as well as the hind legs below the hock joint, move perpendicularly to the ground, with some tendency towards a single track as speed increases. Structural characteristics which interfere with a straight, true stride are to be penalized.

Temperament

The Irish Setter has a rollicking personality. Shyness, hostility or timidity all uncharacteristic of the breed. An outgoing, stable temperament is the essence of the Irish Setter.
